Frequently Asked Questions

Rehearsal

The rehearsal will usually be held a few days before the Wedding.

You are welcome to invite along the various personnel involved in your service (e.g. best man, bridesmaids etc.)

Calling of Banns

If you have an address within the parish you can get married by the calling of Banns.

Please note that your Banns are being read at Mary's on the following three Sundays:

at either our 9.30am Communion Service or our 11.15am TGIS ('Thank God it's Sunday!') Service. You should, if possible, be present for this.

If you don't live in the parish, you must arrange for the Banns to be read in your own church(es). Your church(es) will then provide you with a certificate which **must** be given to us before the wedding day.

If you don't live in the parish and are not having Banns read, it is possible to apply for a Special Licence. This is granted where it is deemed that there are strong and compelling reasons for the marriage to take place at that church or where one of the couple have 'qualifying connections' with the parish eg. lived there as a child.

Flowers

We do offer a floral arrangement service at reasonable cost, contact the Parish Office for more details.

Photographs

Photography is permitted (within certain guidelines) during the service and there are restrictions on the use of video cameras. Please note that if the wedding is videoed, extra charges apply.

Confetti

A sign will be placed outside the south porch-requesting people not to throw confetti in the churchyard.
